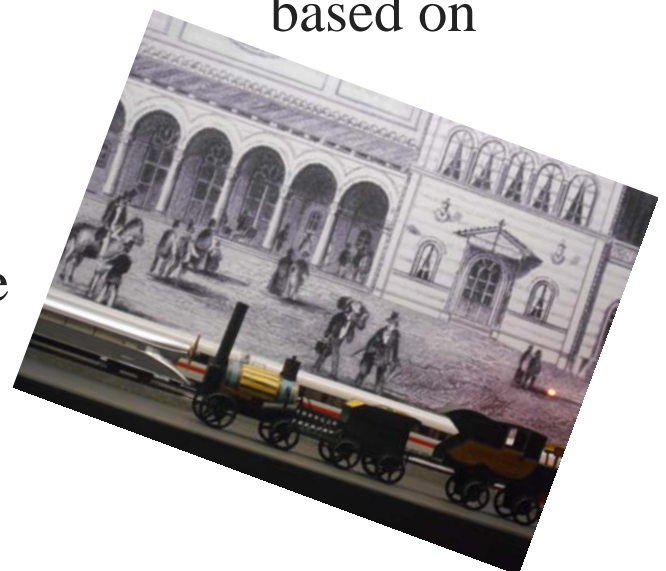


Our visit to the Dasa museum
