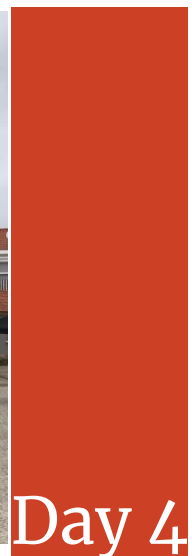
Day 2

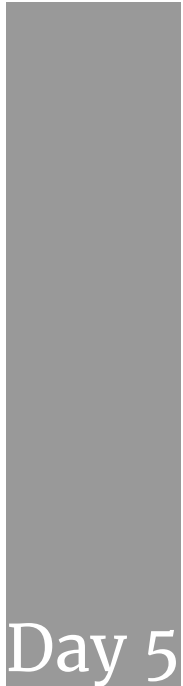
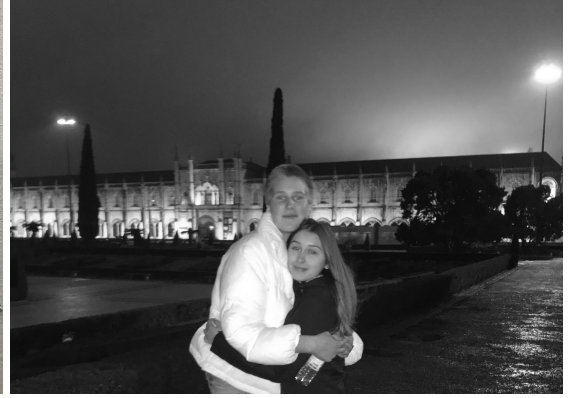


30.01.19

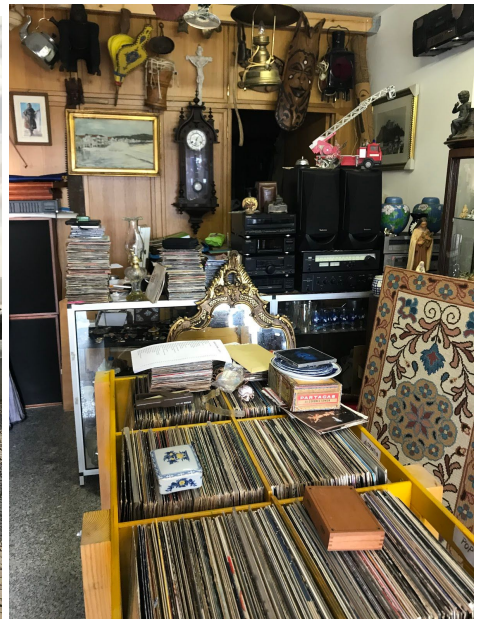
The first one – museum of glass takes place in the Palace, building of neoclassical inspiration, built in the second half of the 18th century and classified as a Public Interest Building.
